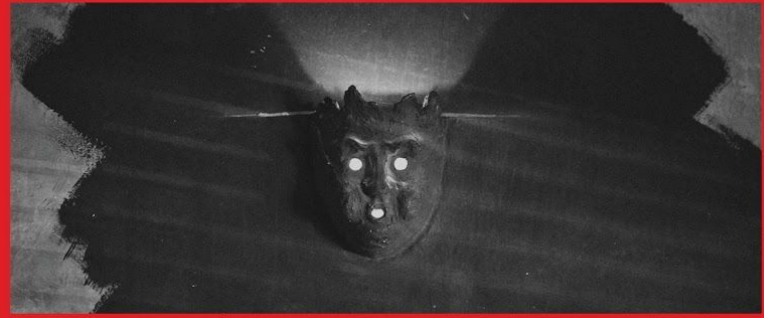

## WHERE TO FIND AUSTRALASIA'S MOST BEAUTIFUL VENUES Eat Drink Design Awards Shortlist 2020

The 2020 [Eat Drink Design Awards](#) shortlist has been announced, revealing the most exceptionally designed hospitality venues across Australia and New Zealand. This year's Awards come at a critical time for the hospitality industry. Like many sectors suffering under lockdown and economic downturn, our beloved cafes, restaurants, bars, clubs and hotels are under extreme duress. It has never been more important to recognise the spaces that bring value and joy to everyday life.

The annual Eat Drink Design Awards recognise excellence and innovation in the design of restaurants, bars, cafes, hotels, nightclubs, temporary venues and retail spaces across Australia and New Zealand. The awards highlight that an exceptional venue isn't only defined by what is served on a plate; a truly exceptional venue incorporates innovative and thoughtful design that heightens the overall hospitality experience of patrons.

Eat Drink Design Awards jury chair and editor of *Artichoke*, Cassie Hansen explained that one of the notable design stories that prevailed in this year's shortlist was the sense of comfort and nostalgia permeating venue designs.

*"Perhaps it is no coincidence that in a time of such upheaval, we have seen designers create spaces that provide familiarity in their appearance and comfort in their feel. Many designers appeared to be in search of an air of nostalgia for the interiors they create, with numerous venues showcasing a modern take on traditional spaces. This year's designers have one foot in the past whilst firmly looking towards the future,"* said Hansen.

In recognition of the longevity and cultural significance that a venue can hold, one long standing venue will also be inducted into the **Eat Drink Design Awards Hall of Fame**. Past winners include the iconic Cumulus Inc by Pascale Gomes-McNab, Cookie by Phillip Schemnitz Architect, Jimmy Watson's Wine Bar by Robin Boyd and Frederick Romberg, Cafe Di Stasio by Allan Powell Architects, Fratelli Paradiso by Mike Murphy with later additions by Mike Hanna and Don Cameron, and Icebergs by Lazzarini Pickering.

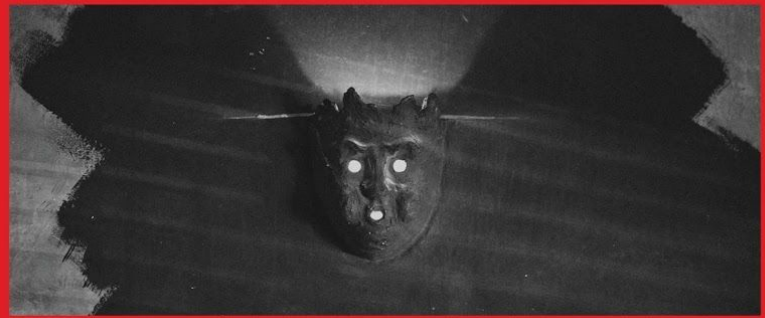

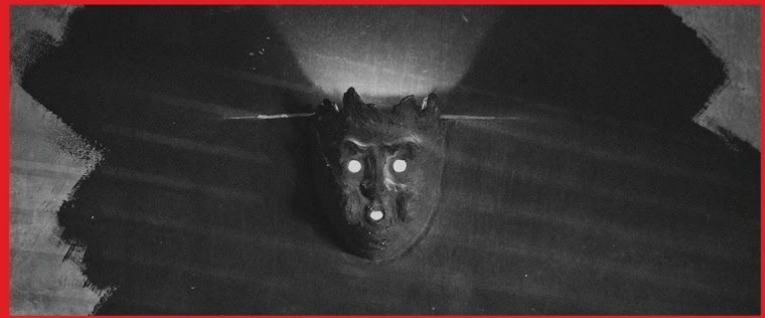

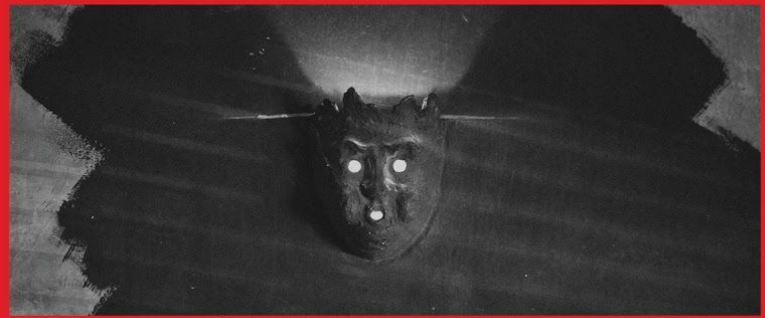
